- 1.1 Qualified Social Worker with recognised professional qualification;
- 1.2 Current HCPC Registration;
- 1.3 Evidence of commitment to further professional learning (e.g. PQ or Advanced Award, attendance at training events).

- 2.1 At least three years post-qualifying experience in child care social work, including some direct experience of undertaking adoption suitability assessments;
- 2.2 Knowledge and experience of adoption and the pertinent issues relevant to families and children:
